



KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

Everyone has Constitutional rights regardless of immigration status or who is president:

- Right to remain silent - notify the officer out loud that you want to remain silent
- Right to talk with a lawyer - you are entitled to a lawyer in criminal court (but not in immigration court - you will have to get your own lawyer).
- Right to refuse to sign any document
- Right to not consent to a search of your home, car, or person (unless they have a warrant signed by a Judge)
- Right to record an interaction (you have to let the person know you are recording)

WARNING: Anything you say to an officer can be used against you. Do not say anything false or untrue.

If you are pulled over by police while driving: you are required to show your driver's license, registration and insurance.

IF ICE COMES TO YOUR HOME:

- Do not open the door! Communicate through a closed window or door and let them know "I don't speak English" if there is no adult at home who speaks English.
- If you can communicate, say: "Please show your ID and an order signed by a judge. ask that they pass is to you under the door or show it through a window. Do not open the door. Take a picture of the warrant to show to a lawyer to verify.
- A valid order must contain the following:
 - The word "court" in the title
 - Your correct full name and address. If your information does not match, the order is not valid.
 - Signature of a Judge
 - Current date range
 - If the order is valid: ICE agents may enter the designated place or home with or without your permission.

WARNING: If you don't communicate with ICE agents, they will likely return or wait outside your house
